

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving the Amendment and Modification to FY 2003 Supplement Budget for  
Baboquivari District Administration in the amount of \$4,000.00)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 03-209**

1 **WHEREAS, the Baboquivari District Administration presents a budget modification and**  
2 **amendment in the amount of four thousand dollars (\$4,000.00) to the FY 2003**  
3 **District Administration Supplement Budget; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the district administration shall transfer funds from the professional services line**  
5 **item to create (3) new line items for the FY 2003 Supplement budget which will be**  
6 **tuition and registration, travel expense and mileage.**

7 **From line item 810.32 Professional Services transfer funds in the amount of \$4,000.00**

8 **(Four thousand dollars and 00/100) and add to the created following line items:**

9 **650.32 Tuition and Registration \$2,000.00 (Two thousand dollars and 00/100).**

10 **660.32 Travel Expense \$1,200.00 (One thousand two hundred dollars and 00/100)**

11 **661.32 Mileage \$800.00 (Eight hundred dollars and 00/100)**

12 **JUSTIFICATION:**

13 **650.32-Tuition and Registration: expense incurred by the District Administration**  
14 **and District Council/Economic Development Committee Members for expenses,**  
15 **which include registration costs, seminars, workshops, conferences etc.**

16 **660.32 Travel Expense: related to airfare, bus fare, travel advances and**  
17 **reimbursement of auto and rental expense calculated according to the ConUS**  
18 **established daily per diem rates for meals and lodging for the locality Auto rental is**  
19 **only permitted when an emergency arises and is only required for the purposes of**  
20 **conducting business while administration employee/district council and Economic**  
21 **Development Committee Members are on business travel.**

22 **661.32 Mileage: For reimbursement of auto related expenses based on actual**  
23 **mileage traveled by privately owned vehicle at the Nation's approved established**  
24 **rate.**

25 **WHEREAS, any changes in the justification, additions and/or transfer of funds between budget**  
26 **line items are to be reviewed and approved by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
27 **Council.**

28 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**  
29 **approves Baboquivari District Administration FY-2003 Supplement Budget**  
30 **Amendment to add the above aforementioned (3) newly created line items.**

6 **of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**  
7 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
8 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




