

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(FY 2004 Elderly Title III B, C-1, C-2, E and Cash in Lieu of Commodities (CILC) Budget**  
**July 01, 2003 - June 30, 2004)**

RESOLUTION NO. 03-212

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated a program for the elderly**  
2 **members of the Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Elderly Program has been made possible in part by**  
4 **Title III of the Older American's Act of 1965 as amended, through the Administration**  
5 **of the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the services provided to elderly members has been beneficial and services continue**  
7 **to be necessary to provide nutritional and social support; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Elderly Program has prepared the FY 2004 budgets for Title III B \$88,190; Title III**  
9 **C-1 \$66,175; Title III C-2 \$40,018; Title III-E \$25,305 and Cash in Lieu of Commodities**  
10 **(CILC) \$5,378. The Title III funds will provide nutritional and social support services**  
11 **to eligible elderly members for period July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council,**

- 13 **1. That it hereby approves the FY 2004 Title III B \$88,190, Title III C-1 \$66,175, Title**  
14 **III C-2 \$40,018, E \$25,305 and Cash in Lieu of Commodities (CILC) \$5,378.00**  
15 **funding to provide nutritional and social support services to eligible elderly**  
16 **members for period July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2004.**
- 17 **2. That it hereby approves the funds to be expended upon approval and acceptance**  
18 **of the grant award.**
- 19 **3. That 10% match is coming from the Tribal budget.**
- 20 **4. The Chairman is hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided**  
21 **however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of this**  
22 **contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.**

23 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
24 **of MAY, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,417.5 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**  
25 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of**  
26 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**  
27 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**  
28 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


