

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the FY 2003 Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Program
Budget Modification/Amendment #1)

RESOLUTION NO. 03-215

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has previously supported the Nation's**
2 **Education Department in submitting a grant proposal and establishing a vocational**
3 **rehabilitation program under Resolution No. 98-202; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation was awarded a grant under the Rehabilitation Services**
5 **Administration's Section 121 (Vocational Rehabilitation Services Projects for**
6 **American Indians with Disabilities) of the Rehabilitation Act and received grant**
7 **notification number H250G980011; and**

8 **WHEREAS, two new line items will be added to budget modification #1 which are 1) 724 Supplies-**
9 **Kitchen 2) 855 Consumables; and**

10 **WHEREAS, services under the Tohono O'odham Vocational Rehabilitation Program will be**
11 **provided to eligible American Indians with disabilities who reside on the Tohono**
12 **O'odham Nation, with enrolled Tohono O'odham members being priority; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the services provided will be consistent with individual strengths, resources,**
14 **priorities, concerns, abilities, capabilities and informed choice of eligible American**
15 **Indians so that they may prepare for and engage in gainful employment; and**

16 **WHEREAS, a carry forward of \$388,477.78 has been identified from FY-2002 and is being**
17 **incorporated into the current program budget of \$433,997.00, which will increase the**
18 **budget to \$822,474.78.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves**
20 **the FY-2003 Tohono O'odham Nation Vocational Rehabilitation Program budget in the**
21 **amount of \$822,474.78 reflecting carry over funds of \$388,477.78.**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham**
23 **Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman is authorized to execute and expand the grant**
24 **award to September 30, 2003, and provide continued culturally appropriate**
25 **vocational rehabilitation services to its eligible consumers, provided however, that**
26 **any amendments affecting the funding levels of this grant shall be submitted for**
27 **further approval.**


