

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of FY 2004 Division of Community Health Services/Tuberculosis
Control Services Program Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 03-285

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Tuberculosis Control Services Program**
2 **to help prevent the spread of the disease through community education, prevention,**
3 **early detection, comprehensive regimens and careful follow up with individuals; and**
4 **WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Services**
5 **Program has been provided in part through supplemental funding sources; and**
6 **WHEREAS, the Division of Community Health Services - Tuberculosis Control Services desires to**
7 **continue the services it provides to TB susceptible patients; and**
8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Services Program has received funding**
9 **from the State of Arizona, Department of Health Services for its program; and**
10 **WHEREAS, a budget in the amount of \$21,356.00 is submitted for review and approval by the**
11 **Department of Human Services, Division of Community Health to utilize funds to**
12 **continue the services it provides.**

13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 14 **1. It hereby approves the proposal for funding of the Tohono O'odham**
15 **Tuberculosis Control Services Program from the State of Arizona Department of**
16 **Health Services and approves expenditures in accordance with the attached**
17 **budget in the amount of \$21,356.00.**
- 18 **2. That the duration of this contract shall be from July 01, 2002 and remain in effect**
19 **as long as the Arizona Department of Health Services agrees to fund the Tohono**
20 **O'odham Tuberculosis Control Services Program.**
- 21 **3. The Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman**
22 **and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this**
23 **contract.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03RD, Day**
25 **of JUNE, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0- AGAINST;**
26 **-0- NOT VOTING; and [-0-] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of**
27 **Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
28 **Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
29 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**

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
