

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorizing Tohono O'odham Nation Delegation to the National Congress of American  
Indians' 2003 Mid-Year Session)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 03-290**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is vested with the power to consult with**  
2 **other Indian tribes on all matters within the Council's authority (Constitution of the**  
3 **Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VI, Section 1(f)); and**

4 **WHEREAS, the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI) will hold its 2003 Mid-Year Session**  
5 **on the Gila River Indian Reservation, Phoenix, Az on June 15-18, 2003; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is a member in good standing with NCAI; and**

7 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to continue its National-level**  
8 **involvement in current issues by participating in the NCAI 2003 Mid-Year Session.**

9 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby**


