

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Sanitation Facilities Deficiency System Priority Ranking)**

RESOLUTION NO. 03-323

1 WHEREAS, Indian Health Service, Division of Environmental Health and Engineering (DEH&E)
2 conducts an assessment of Sanitation Facilities Deficiencies, annually; and

3 WHEREAS, the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering assessment does have an
4 impact upon congressional appropriations and IHS allocation of funds; and

5 WHEREAS, Indian Health Services has provided for Tribal Priority ranking of the four (4) most
6 critical projects and does allocate points impacting upon overall prioritization of
7 projects; and

8 WHEREAS, the Division of Environmental Health and Engineering has provided
9 recommendations to the Tohono O'odham Nation regarding the most critical needs.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation has reviewed and approved
11 the entire priority list and has determined that the following deficiencies are the four
12 most critical and desirable, in descending order of prioritization:

- 13 1. Chuichu - Whitehorse Pass Intertie
- 14 2. Gunsight Water
- 15 3. Crowhang Water and Sewer
- 16 4. Jackrabbit Individual Water and Sewer

17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11TH Day
18 of JULY, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,728.45 FOR; 901.25
19 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
20 Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono
21 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
22 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
23 Stat. 984).
