

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Appointment of Patricia Cruz to the Arizona Advisory Council on Indian Health Care)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 03-356**

1 **WHEREAS, the State of Arizona has created an Advisory Council on Indian Health Care ("Advisory**  
2 **Council") to address the health care needs of American Indians within Arizona; and**

3 **WHEREAS, each Arizona Indian tribe may nominate a member for appointment to the Advisory**  
4 **Council and submit the nomination to the Governor of the State of Arizona; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council Health and Human Services Committee ("HHS Committee")**  
6 **has been delegated authority to consult with tribal, federal, state and local**  
7 **governments, their departments, agencies, or political subdivisions on programs and**  
8 **activities relating to human health and welfare (Plan of Operation for HHS**  
9 **Committee adopted pursuant to Legislative Order No. 02-093); and**

10 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 2000-006, Resolution No. 01-359, and Resolution No. 02-601 the**  
11 **Tohono O'odham Nation nominated and supported the appointment of former HHS**  
12 **Committee Chairman Albert Manuel, Jr. to the Advisory Council; and**

13 **WHEREAS, former Councilman Albert Manuel Jr. has since resigned from the Advisory Council;**  
14 **and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services Committee recommends that Councilwoman Patricia**  
16 **Cruz be appointed to the Advisory Council to replace former Councilman Manuel and**  
17 **requests that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council support this nomination.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**  
19 **does hereby nominate and recommend to the Governor of Arizona that Health and**  
20 **Human Services Committee Member Patricia Cruz be appointed to the Advisory**  
21 **Council on Indian Health Care to replace former Councilman Albert Manuel Jr. for**  
22 **the term ending January 15, 2005.**


23 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that any appointment made pursuant to this resolution**  
24 **shall immediately expire if Councilwoman Cruz vacates her office as a Legislative**  
25 **Council Representative for any reason.**

26 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06<sup>TH</sup>, Day**  
27 **of AUGUST, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,362.5 FOR; 182.05**  
28 **AGAINST; 85.15 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
29 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
30 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
31 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
32 **Stat. 984).**


