## **RESOLUTION NO.** 03-359

1	WHEREAS,	by Resolution No. 08-70 the Nation established the Papago Tribal Utility Authority,
2		now known as Tohono O'odham Utility Authority (TOUA) for purposes of constructing,
3		maintaining and operating various utility systems within the Nation to be owned
4		wholly by the Nation; and
5	WHEREAS,	TOUA requests permission for a Right-of-Way to construct a 4" Water Main and
6		related facilities to the Quijotoa Pentecostal Church located between the
7		communities of Upper and Lower Covered Wells, Gu Achi District, Tohono O'odham
8		Nation; and
9	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did pass Resolution No. 447-90 (Amending
10		the Restated Plan of Operation of the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority) and
11		Resolution No. 91-175 (Adopting Second Restated Plan of Operation for the Tohono
12		O'odham Utility Authority) which requires the Authority to submit for prior review
13		and approval of the Legislative Council and each affected District any proposed utility
14		easement; and
15	WHEREAS,	the requested 1,150' Right-of-Way described is from the tie-in point on the Covered
16		Wells Regional Water System to the property line of the Wine Gold Mine patent land
17		parcel of the Quijotoa Pentecostal Church, entirely on Tohono O'odham Reservation
18		Lands; and
19	WHEREAS,	TOUA has respectfully submitted all documents and pertinent information (attached
20		hereto and incorporated herein by reference) for uses consistent with the authorized
21		purposes of TOUA; and
22	WHEREAS,	the Water Main Extension and related facilities will be of substantial benefit to
23		Covered Wells Communities, the Tohono O'odham Nation and their respective
24		members; and
25	WHEREAS,	the Gu Achi District Council approved the Water Main Extension by its Resolution No.
26		0703-343; and
27	WHEREAS,	the Natural Resources Committee reviewed the request on 06 August 2003 and by
28		consensus does recommend approval thereof by the Legislative Council.
29	NOW, THER	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby
30		approve the Right-of-Way as requested by TOUA for the 4" Water Main Extension and
