## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Authorizing Execution of Landowner Selection Form for San Lucy Farm)

RESOLUTION NO. 03-363

1	WHEREAS,	the San Lucy Farm is located within the Central Arizona Irrigation and Drainage
2		District ("CAIDD"); and
3	WHEREAS,	CAIDD delivers water to the San Lucy Farm and other agricultural enterprises within
4		CAIDD; and
5	WHEREAS,	CAIDD entered into a subcontract on November 21, 1983 with the United States and
6		the  Central Arizona  Water  Conservation  District  (``CAWCD'') for  the  delivery  of  Central  delivery
7		Arizona Project ("CAP") water (the "CAIDD Subcontract"); and
8	WHEREAS,	CAIDD entered into an agreement with CAWCD providing for the delivery of excess
9		CAP water ("Excess CAP Water"), dated January 1, 1994 (the "Excess Water
10		Agreement"); and
11	WHEREAS,	Excess CAP Water is a surplus supply of water not committed for delivery to CAWCD
12		contractors or subcontractors; and
13	WHEREAS,	the term of the Excess Water Agreement expires on December 31, 2003; and
14	WHEREAS,	CAWCD has set aside 400,000 acre-feet of CAP water (the "Settlement Pool") for CAIDD
15		and other agricultural districts which agree to relinquish their rights under the
16		CAIDD Subcontract and participate in the Arizona Water Settlement Agreement (the Arizona Caidal Caid
17		"Settlement Agreement"); and
18	WHEREAS,	a vote of CAIDD landowners approved CAIDD's participation in the Settlement
19		Agreement on the condition the Settlement Agreement is finalized; and
20	WHEREAS,	the Settlement Pool is the only Excess Water available for delivery to CAIDD; and
21	WHEREAS,	$for calendar year 2004, those {\it CAIDD landowners who}\ refuse to\ relinquish\ their\ rights$
22		under the CAIDD Subcontract will be charged \$74.00 per acre-foot of CAP water
23		delivered or \$46 for each acre-foot not ordered by the landowner or which the
24		landowner orders but declines to accept delivery; and
25	WHEREAS,	if all  conditions  in  the  Settlement  Agreement  are  satisfied  by  December  31,2007,  the
26		Settlement Pool of Excess Water is available for calendar years 2004 through 2030 at

29	WHEREAS,	if all conditions in the Settlement Agreement are not satisfied by December 31, 2007,
30		the Settlement Pool of Excess water is available for calendar years 2004 through 2007

WHEREAS,	a Landowner Selection Form for the San Lucy Farm has been submitted to the Tohono
	O'odham Nation, a copy of which is attached hereto; and
WHEREAS,	execution of the Landowner Selection Form will relinquish the Nation's rights under
	the CAIDD Subcontract for the San Lucy Farm and entitle the Nation to receive Excess
	Water from the Settlement Pool at \$28 per acre-foot; and
WHEREAS,	selection by the Nation to retain rights under the CAIDD Subcontract will result in a
	per acre-foot cost of \$74.00 for calendar year 2004, and \$46.00 per acre-foot for water
	not ordered or water ordered for which delivery is refused; and
WHEREAS,	the Agriculture Committee, the Water Resources Committee and the Tohono
	O'odham Farming Authority recommend that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
	Council authorize execution of the Landowner Selection Form for the San Lucy Farm
NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:
	1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the completion and execution
	of the Landowner Selection Form for the San Lucy Farm, in the form attached
	hereto.
	2. The Chairwoman of the Nation is authorized to complete and execute the
	Landowner Selection Form and deliver the Form to the Central Arizona
	Irrigation and Drainage District.
