

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Approval of Budget Amendment #1 authorizing the transfer of funds in the amount of \$29,348 from Employee Commuting account no. 01-3026 to the DPS Law Enforcement Program Account 01-1090-771; and approval of Budget Modification for the identified savings)

RESOLUTION NO. 03-393

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Police Department maintains and operates a fleet of 121**
2 **vehicles; these vehicles are in operation under patrol, ranger, corrections, criminal**
3 **investigations, undercover, and support services; TOPD operates continuously on 365**
4 **days a year, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week schedule; and**

5 **WHEREAS, there are a limited number of vehicles equipped according to specifications for law**
6 **enforcement purposes and said vehicles exceed the normal mileage expectations and**
7 **wear and tear, which results in immense expenses; and**

8 **WHEREAS, TOPD has depleted its line item for 771 RM Vehicles; and has identified savings in its**
9 **budget to make modifications to line item 771 RM Vehicles and 810 Professional**
10 **services; and**

11 **WHEREAS, TOPD savings are not sufficient to cover the assessment for expenses; and**

12 **WHEREAS, TOPD has requested additional funds from Executive to fund 771 RM Vehicles; and**

13 **WHEREAS, Executive has identified unused funds in Employee Commuting Budget account no.**
14 **01-3026 in the amount of \$29,348; and**

15 **WHEREAS, in order to promptly respond to this situation, Executive requests a Budget**
16 **Amendment No. 1 authorizing the transfer of \$29,348 from Employee Commuting**
17 **Account no 01-3026 to T.O.P.D. Account no. 01-1090-771.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does**
19 **hereby approve the transfer of \$29,348.00 from the Employee Commuting Budget (01-**
20 **3026) to the DPS Law Enforcement Budget (01-1090-771) and budget modification.**

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22 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH Day**
23 **of SEPTEMBER, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0-**
24 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [0] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**
25 **1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
26 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
27 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
28 **Stat. 984).**
