11		the FY 2004 Head Start Program Application with the understanding that the Nation					
12		accepts the grant in the amount of \$1,575,029.00; and					
13	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation must meet the 20% Tribal Match requirements totaling					
14		\$393,757.00, which is comprised of a cash match in the amount of \$322,493.02 and					
15		\$71,263.98 of other in-kind contributions such as volunteer hours, building usage,					
16		and utilities.

18		authorizes the Executive Branch to submit the Head Start Grant to apply for federal					
19		funds in the amount of \$1,575,029.00 for FY 2004.
