6	2003 status-quo levels.						
7	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby						
8	approves the attached projected revenues in the amount of \$39,296,219 for the						
9	purpose of funding the FY 2004 general fund budgets of the Tohono O'odham Nation						
10	for a six-month period based on status-quo levels, resulting in budgets funded at no						
11	more than one-half of the general fund budget base for FY 2003.						
12	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that this six-month period pertains to budgets under the general fund						
13	only and does not include grants & contracts, initiative, capital, or revenue budgets.						
14	The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 11^{TH} . Day						
15	of <u>SEPTEMBER, 2003</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>2,629.7</u> FOR; <u>-0-</u>						
16	AGAINST; <u>-0-</u> NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by						
17	Section 1 <u>(d)(2) & (3)</u> of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the						
18	Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant						
19	Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
