

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Westside Health Clinic 27-unit Staff Quarters Plan)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 03-412**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation entered into a Joint Venture Agreement ("Agreement")**  
2 **with the Indian Health Service/Public Health Service, United States Government**  
3 **pursuant to Resolution No. 03-203; and**

4 **WHEREAS, in accordance with Article 6.5.2 of the Agreement, the Tohono O'odham Nation**  
5 **"agrees to develop a plan in cooperation with the I.H.S., no later than four months**  
6 **from the date of this Agreement to address the construction plan, including the**  
7 **schedule for the Nation to provide the required staff quarters"; and**

8 **WHEREAS, as the Agreement was signed on May 22, 2003, the Nation and the Indian Health**  
9 **Service have a deadline to "develop a plan" by September 22, 2003; and**

10 **WHEREAS, funding appropriation by the Tohono O'odham Nation is not required at the time the**  
11 **plan is agreed upon by both the Indian Health Service and the Tohono O'odham**  
12 **Nation but will be required prior to construction bid; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Program Justification Document Quarters ("PJDQ") has been established for the**  
14 **Quarters at the proposed Westside Health Clinic by the Indian Health Service and**  
15 **Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Nation currently has funding in the amount of \$1,000,000 in construction funds**  
17 **that can be allocated for use in the design package for the 27-unit staff quarters as**  
18 **directed by the PJDQ; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the \$1,000,000 available shall cover expenses incurred for design and site**  
20 **development only; and**

21 **WHEREAS, once the \$1,000,000 is expended, additional funding will be required to begin**  
22 **construction of the staff quarters.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council shall permit use**  
24 **of the \$1,000,000 from the construction budget of the Westside Health Clinic to be**  
25 **used for design and site development of the 27-unit staff quarters.**

26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislation Council shall appropriate**  
27 **funding to construct the 27-unit staff quarters for the Westside Health Clinic by**  
28 **December 22, 2003, three months after the housing plan due date and the projected**  
29 **construction bid date, based on timelines.**

1 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts the plan as  
2 submitted in this resolution.

3 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 12<sup>TH</sup> Day  
4 of SEPTEMBER, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0-  
5 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
6 Section 1 (d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the  
7 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
8 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
9 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
