

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Adopting Special Projects Office FY 2004 Budget)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 03-427**

1 **WHEREAS, the Special Projects Office currently provides project management and contracting**  
2 **in architectural design, general construction contracting, infrastructure development**  
3 **and long-range facilities planning for the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Special Projects Office has established a continuity of services for direct and day**  
5 **to day project management for funded projects entering into site development, pre-**  
6 **design, architecture and engineering design, commencing with bidding and**  
7 **contracting with a design team; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council, through resolution #03-029, has previously authorized the**  
9 **Special Projects Office to operate during fiscal year 2003; and**

10 **WHEREAS, funds are available in the Reserve Accounts for Early Childhood Head Start, Dialysis**  
11 **Center and Westside Health Clinic, which may be used to consolidate the Special**  
12 **Projects Office's Administration expense requirements for each project; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Special Projects Office's proposed, consolidated Fiscal Year 2004 Budget requires**  
14 **\$266,761.78 to administer the Westside Health Clinic Project at 40%, the Dialysis**  
15 **Facility Project at 20% and the Head Start Facilities Project at 20%.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**  
17 **the use of funds specified from the following reserve accounts to fund the Special**  
18 **Projects Office FY 2004 Budget; Early Childhood Head Start Facilities, Dialysis Center**  
19 **Reserve and Westside Health Center Reserve.**

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council hereby approves and authorizes the**  
21 **consolidation of expenditures for the projects administered by the Special Projects**  
22 **Office according to the fiscal year 2004 budget in the amount of \$266,761.78 as**  
23 **attached.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 29<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
26 **of SEPTEMBER, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,080.95 FOR;**  
27 **548.75 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
28 **by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**  
29 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


