	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council established the Cultural Affairs Program in						
9		1997; and						
10	WHEREAS,	Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Resolution No. 2002-240 established the						
11		Cultural Affairs Dedicated Revenue Account (Account # 44-1506 411) for the deposit						
12	of funds received by the Cultural Affairs Program from outside sources and							
13	authorized the Cultural Affairs Program to expend these funds for operational							
14	purposes consistent with approved budgets.

16	authorizes the Cultural Affairs Program to expend \$5,588 in its dedicated revenue							
17	account as itemized in the attached FY 2004 Budget.
