

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY 2004 State of Arizona Reimbursable Budgets: Child and Adult Care  
Food Program and Arizona Long Term Care Services Program)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 03-439**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has historically contracted certain functions from the**  
2 **State of Arizona; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Department of Education through the Child and Adult Care Food Program**  
4 **-Service Agreement provided reimbursement of funds for food costs incurred based**  
5 **on the guidelines identified in the agreement; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been providing Arizona Long Term Care Services**  
7 **(ALTCS) case management services since June 1996 and has been receiving**  
8 **reimbursement from the State of Arizona; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Executive Branch developed and obtained committee approval of the following**  
10 **budgets as attached and incorporated by this reference, to be effective October 1,**  
11 **2003 through September 30, 2004 and request authorization to expend the funds:**

- 12 1. **Child and Adult Care Food Program - \$40,000**  
13 2. **Arizona Long Term Care Services Program - \$233,086.95.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Executive Branch is hereby authorized to expend**  
15 **funds for the programs listed herein and as attached in the amounts indicated,**  
16 **effective October 1, 2003 through September 30, 2004:**

- 17 1. **Child and Adult Care Food Program - \$40,000**  
18 2. **Arizona Long Term Care Services Program - \$233,086.95.**

19 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 30<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
20 **of SEPTEMBER, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,080.95 FOR;**  
21 **548.75 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council**  
22 **by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by**  
23 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
24 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
25 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


