8	WHEREAS,	the Water Resources Study Program has proposed a budget for fiscal year 2004 in the
9		amount of \$953,560.34; and
10	WHEREAS,	this budget has been reviewed by the Water Resources Committee and the Budget and
11		Finance Committee and is recommended for approval by the Legislative Council.
12	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Executive Branch is hereby authorized to expend
13		funds for the programs listed herein and as attached in the amount of \$953,560.34,
14		effective October 1, 2003 through September 30, 2004.
