9	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did approve the TOUA Subsidy
10		Implementation Plan of November 3, 1998 by Resolution No. 98-473; and
11	WHEREAS,	TOUA has applied \$4,000,000 to eligible members through September 2003 and the
12		available funding has been exhausted; and
13	WHEREAS,	TOUA has performed an analysis of the past year and projects that the need for the
14		Subsidy will meet or exceed \$1 million for FY 2003.
