1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated a program for the Elderly**
2 **members of the Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Elderly Program has been made possible in part by**
4 **Title III of the Older American's Act of 1965 as amended, through the Administration**
5 **of the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the services provided to Elderly members has been beneficial and services continue**
7 **to be necessary to provide nutritional and social support; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Elderly Program Title III budgets has been amended to increase or decrease the**
9 **funds in order for the budgets to reflect the funding amounts shown on the Grant**
10 **Award Letter; and**
