

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing the San Xavier District to Submit a P.L. 93-638 Contract Application
to the BIA to Fund a Mining Consultant)**

RESOLUTION NO. 03-470

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Council has the authority to transfer its P.L. 638 responsibilities**
2 **to a district of the Tohono O'odham Nation when necessary or as requested; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council has the responsibility to act in the best interests of all**
4 **people, allottees or heirs to or those individuals having interests in allotted lands, as**
5 **well as non-allottees; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the District requires the services of mining consultant to assist the San Xavier**
7 **Allottees Association to negotiate new Asarco mining agreements and a**
8 **comprehensive settlement of other outstanding Asarco issues; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the District does not have the expertise to handle these technical matters; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has allocated \$50,000 from year-end FY03 funds to the**
11 **BIA Sells Agency to be contracted under P.L. 93-638 to the San Xavier District to allow**
12 **the District to hire a mining consultant; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the District has prepared and submitted a P.L. 93-638 contract application to the BIA**
14 **Sells Agency to obtain a contract allocating the above referenced funds to the District**
15 **to hire a mining consultant.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby**
17 **authorizes the San Xavier District to submit a P.L. 93-638 contract application to the**
18 **BIA Sells Agency to secure the \$50,000 allocated to the BIA from year-end FY 03 funds**
19 **for the San Xavier District to hire a mining consultant.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH. Day**
21 **of OCTOBER, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0-**
22 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
23 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
24 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
25 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
26 **Stat. 984).**
