12		the District to hire a mining consultant; and
13	WHEREAS,	the District has prepared and submitted a P.L. 93-638 contract application to the BIA
14		Sells Agency to obtain a contract allocating the above referenced funds to the District
15		to hire a mining consultant.

17		authorizes the San Xavier District to submit a P.L. 93-638 contract application to the
