

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Agreement Between the
Pascua Yaqui Tribe and the Tohono O'odham Nation)

RESOLUTION NO. 03-477

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Police Department ("TOPD") is responsible for providing law**
2 **enforcement services to the Tohono O'odham Nation including lands on the eastern**
3 **side of the Nation and at San Xavier District; and**

4 **WHEREAS, TOPD has limited resources and personnel and on occasion may find it expedient to**
5 **request assistance from law enforcement jurisdictions with personnel and resources**
6 **close to the Nation's lands; and**

7 **WHEREAS, representatives of the Tohono O'odham Nation have negotiated a mutual aid**
8 **agreement with the Pascua Yaqui Tribe under which each tribal nation may request**
9 **assistance from the other, and each tribal nation's police department will respond**
10 **to the request if able to do so, so long as the assistance will not conflict with that**
11 **police department's duties within its own boundaries; and**

12 **WHEREAS, entering into this mutual aid agreement is in the best interests of the Tohono**
13 **O'odham Nation and will be mutually beneficial to the parties; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council has passed a resolution of support for the mutual aid**
15 **agreement in the form of Resolution No. SXDC 09-03-16, attached hereto for**
16 **reference; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee has reviewed the mutual aid agreement and**
18 **recommends approval by the Legislative Council.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
20 **Mutual Protection and Law Enforcement Agreement Between the Pascua Yaqui Tribe**
21 **and the Tohono O'odham Nation substantially in the form attached hereto, and**
22 **authorizes the Chairwoman of the Nation to execute the agreement on behalf of the**
23 **Nation.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 08TH. Day**
25 **of OCTOBER, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,438.3 FOR; -0-**
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 191.4 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
28 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
30 **Stat. 984).**
