RESOLUTION NO. 03-483

1 WHEREAS, on October 07, 2003, a special meeting was held by the Hickiwan District Council, to
2 discuss the FY 2004 Budget; and

3 WHEREAS, the Hickiwan district Council did see a need to request for continuance of the FY 2003
4 Budget, this would allow the District time to hear feed back from the seven
5 Communities for approval; and


6 WHEREAS, the FY 2004 Budget will be presented at the November Session of the Tohono O'odham
7 Legislative Council.

8 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O;odham Legislative Council supports and
9 approves the continuing use of the FY 2003 Budget for the Hickiwan District.

10 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Hickiwan District has advised that there is sufficient funds in
11 the Wachovia Securities to cover cost for the Hickiwan District.

12 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09TH. Day
13 of OCTOBER, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0-
14 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
15 Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
16 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
17 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
