

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Cultural Affairs - Nation's Reburial Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 03-487

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Members up hold and respect the Culture, Traditions and**
2 **Heritage from Ancestral past; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council passed Resolution #2000-275 appropriating**
4 **funds for the Culture Center Museum; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Cultural Preservation Committee and the Nation's Cultural Affairs Office has**
6 **acknowledged that there is a need for funding to assist the Annual Nation's Reburial**
7 **Ceremony, which takes place in November of every year, and has composed the**
8 **budget in the amount of \$10,000.00 attached hereto and recommends for approval**
9 **of the Legislative Council; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance Committee recommends the funds to be taken from the**
11 **Cultural Center Museum Reserve.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:**

- 13 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the Nation's Reburial Budget**
14 **for FY 2004 in the amount of \$10,000.00.**
- 15 **2. Funding for the Reburial Budget will be taken from the Cultural Center Museum**
16 **Reserve.**
- 17 **3. Any amendments and modifications will be reviewed and approved by the**
18 **Cultural Preservation Committee and Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.**
- 19 **4. The Cultural Affairs Office will maintain and administer the Reburial Budget.**

20 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH. Day**
21 **of OCTOBER, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,329.15 FOR; 300.5**
22 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
23 **Section 1 (d)(2)&(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
24 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
25 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
26 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
