

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of the Transfer of BIA Quarters No. 24 and No. 25)

RESOLUTION NO. 03-489

1 **WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) Papago Indian Agency, has identified federal**
2 **government furnished Quarters No. 24 and No. 25, located in Sells, as buildings no**
3 **longer utilizable by the BIA and is offering the Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation) these**
4 **quarters for the Nation's use; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Chairwoman of the Tohono O'odham Nation has determined that these buildings**
6 **are needed for occupancy by the Executive Branch and has formally requested the**
7 **transfer of the title for Quarters No. 24 and No. 25 to the Nation; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the BIA requires a Tribal Resolution to complete the transfer of the buildings**
9 **described as:**

- 10 **1. Government Furnished Quarters No. 24, two-bedroom house with 1,371 square**
11 **feet, that is located within the BIA facility compound in Sells. Housing is**
12 **unfurnished with concrete slab on grade with standard equipment that will stay**
13 **with house are hot water heater, heating furnace, gas meter and refrigerator.**
- 14 **2. Government Furnished Garage building No. 25 with 648 square feet that is also**
15 **located within the BIA facility compound in Sells.**

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
17 **transfer of federal government furnished Quarters No. 24 and No. 25 that is**
18 **located within the BIA Facility Compound in Sells to the Tohono O'odham Nation**
19 **for its use.**

20 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby recommends that**
21 **the Chairwoman of the Nation secure all necessary documentation to complete**
22 **its transfer, and authorize the Chairwoman to execute any such documents on**
23 **behalf of the Nation.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 10TH Day**
25 **of OCTOBER, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,460.85 FOR; 530.40**
26 **AGAINST; 638.45 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
28 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
29 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
30 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
