14		representation in these proceedings and other matters assigned by the Attorney

16	WHEREAS,	the Attorney General has proposed an attorney contract with the Attorneys, in the				
17		amount of \$10,000, a copy of which is attached hereto; and				
18	WHEREAS,	the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative Council of				
19		an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys on such terms.
