

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving an Attorney Contract with the Law Firm of Quigley & Whitehill, P.L.C.)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 03-509**

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 02-520, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approved an**  
2 **Attorney Contract with the law firm of Quigley & Whitehill, P.L.C. (the "Attorneys") for**  
3 **Fiscal Year 2003, to provide legal representation with respect to matters affecting the**  
4 **trust status of the San Lucy Farm and litigation and negotiations related to the**  
5 **Central Arizona Project (CAP); and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract expired on September 30, 2003; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the CAP litigation is pending and certain issues regarding the trust status of the San**  
8 **Lucy Farm are unresolved; and**

9 **WHEREAS, continued representation regarding ongoing matters is required to protect the**  
10 **Nation's interests; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Operating Budget for the Office of Attorney General for the six-month period**  
12 **ending March 31, 2004, as approved by the Legislative Council in Resolution No. 03-**  
13 **424, has sufficient funds for an attorney contract in the amount of \$10,000 for**  
14 **representation in these proceedings and other matters assigned by the Attorney**  
15 **General; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Attorney General has proposed an attorney contract with the Attorneys, in the**  
17 **amount of \$10,000, a copy of which is attached hereto; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative Council of**  
19 **an Attorney Contract with the Attorneys on such terms.**

20 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 21 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves an Attorney Contract**  
22 **with the Attorneys in the amount of \$10,000 for the six-month period ending**  
23 **March 31, 2004, and in the form attached hereto.**
- 24 **2. Funding for the Attorney Contract shall be provided under the authority of**  
25 **Resolution No. 03-424 in the operating budget for the Office of Attorney General.**
- 26 **3. The Chairwoman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute the Attorney**  
27 **Contract.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 04<sup>TH</sup> Day**  
29 **of NOVEMBER, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0-**  
30 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and -0- ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section**  
31 **2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
32 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
33 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
34 **Stat. 984).**
