

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Tohono O'odham Utility Authority Gu Vo Wastewater & Lagoon System
Right-of-Way, Gu Vo District, Tohono O'odham Nation)

RESOLUTION NO. 03-528

1 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 08-70 the Nation established the Papago Tribal Utility Authority,**
2 **now known as Tohono O'odham Utility Authority (TOUA) for purposes of constructing,**
3 **maintaining and operating various utility systems within the Nation to be owned**
4 **wholly by the Nation; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did pass Resolution No. 447-90 (Amending**
6 **the Restated Plan of Operation of the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority) and**
7 **Resolution No. 91-175 (Adopting Second Restated Plan of Operation for the Tohono**
8 **O'odham Utility Authority) which requires the Authority to submit for prior review**
9 **and approval of the Legislative Council and each affected District any proposed utility**
10 **easement; and**

11 **WHEREAS, TOUA requests permission for a Right-of-Way to construct the Gu Vo Wastewater &**
12 **Lagoon System and related facilities to serve the community of Gu Vo, Gu Vo District,**
13 **Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

14 **WHEREAS, TOUA has respectfully submitted all documents and pertinent information (attached**
15 **hereto and incorporated herein by reference) for uses consistent with the authorized**
16 **purposes of TOUA; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Gu Vo Wastewater & Lagoon System and related facilities will be of substantial**
18 **benefit to the Gu Vo Community, Gu Vo District, the Tohono O'odham Nation and**
19 **their respective members; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Gu Vo District Governing Council did support the Right-of-Way request and**
21 **passed Resolution No. GV03-116; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee did review the requested Right-of-Way on 05**
23 **November 2003 and by consensus does recommend further approval thereof by the**
24 **Legislative Council.**

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby**
26 **approve the Right-of-Way as requested by TOUA for the Gu Vo Wastewater & Lagoon**
27 **System and related facilities in the location (as more fully described in the attached**
28 **Right-of-Way Map & Legal Description) and construction by TOUA or its designated**
29 **subsidiaries for uses consistent with the authorized purposes of TOUA.**


