9		${\bf and approval of the Legislative Council and each affected District any proposed utility}$

11	WHEREAS,	TOUA requests permission for a Right-of-Way to construct the Gu Vo Wastewater &
12		Lagoon System and related facilities to serve the community of GuVo, GuVo District,
13		Tohono O'odham Nation; and
14	WHEREAS,	${\bf TOUA has respect fully submitted all documents and pertinent information (attached all documents and all document all all document all all all all all all all al$
15		here to and incorporated here in by reference) for uses consistent with the authorized
16		purposes of TOUA; and
17	WHEREAS,	the Gu Vo Wastewater & Lagoon System and related facilities will be of substantial
18		benefit to the Gu Vo Community, Gu Vo District, the Tohono O'odham Nation and
19		their respective members; and
20	WHEREAS,	the Gu Vo District Governing Council did support the Right-of-Way request and
21		passed Resolution No. GV03-116; and
22	WHEREAS,	the Natural Resources Committee did review the requested Right-of-Way on 05
23		November 2003 and by consensus does recommend further approval thereof by the $$
24		Legislative Council.
25	NOW, THER	REFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby
26		approve the Right-of-Way as requested by TOUA for the Gu Vo Wastewater & Lagoon
27		System and related facilities in the location (as more fully described in the attached
28		Right-of-Way Map & Legal Description) and construction by TOUA or its designated
29		subsidiaries for uses consistent with the authorized purposes of TOUA.
