

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Tribal Representation for the Tucson Area Representatives to
the Tribal Leaders Diabetes Committee)

RESOLUTION NO. 03-530

1 **WHEREAS, the Tribal Leaders Diabetes Committee (TLDC) is a non-profit organization**
2 **representing all federally recognized tribes in the United States in advocating for the**
3 **improvement of diabetes care and prevention among American Indians; and**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tribal Leaders Diabetes Committee was created by the Director of the U.S. Indian**
5 **Health Service (Indian Health Services) as an advisory committee to the Indian Health**
6 **Services in matters related to the Special Diabetes Programs for Indians (SDPI); and**

7 **WHEREAS, the SDPI was appropriated through the Balanced Budget Act of 1997; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the SDPI was expanded through the Federal Spending Act of 2000; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Tribal Leaders Diabetes Committee members and alternate's represent each of**
10 **the twelve Indian Health Service Areas, and are generally appointed at large by tribal**
11 **governmental officials within each Area; and**

12 **WHEREAS, since 1997 the Tohono O'odham Nation has had a representative to serve on the**
13 **Tribal Leaders Diabetes Committee; and**

14 **WHEREAS, traditionally, the members of the TLDC are elected tribal leaders; and**

15 **WHEREAS, at the recommendation of the Health and Human Services Oversight Committee, as**
16 **elected official Councilwoman Sandra Ortega, to be recommended to be the Tucson**
17 **Area representative to the TLDC and Councilman Isidro Lopez as the alternate**
18 **Tucson Area Representative to the TLDC.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby:**

- 20 **1. Recommends and approves Councilwoman Sandra Ortega as the Tucson Area**
21 **representative to the TLDC and Councilman Isidro Lopez as the alternate.**
- 22 **2. Requests that Dr. Charles Grim, Director of the Indian Health Service, the Current**
23 **Co-Chairs and the TLDC recognize Councilwoman Sandra Ortega as the Tucson**
24 **Area Representative and Councilman Isidro Lopez as the alternate.**
- 25 **3. This resolution shall immediately expire if Councilman Lopez and/or**
26 **Councilwoman Ortega vacates their office as Legislative Council Representatives**
27 **for any reason.**

28 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 07TH, Day**
29 **of NOVEMBER, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,370.8 FOR; -0-**
30 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 258.9 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
31 **Section 1 (i) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
32 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
33 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
34 **Stat. 984).**


