

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Setting December 16, 2003 Special Session to Address the Administrative Plan and  
the Proposed Gaming Revenue Formula Change)**

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 03-545**

1 **WHEREAS, "The Legislative Council may, by majority vote, call for a Special Session to be held**  
2 **for the purposes of completing unfinished agenda, addressing issues requiring an**  
3 **Executive Session, and/or reviewing special reports from Committees, Programs**  
4 **or other sources." (Legislative Rules, Article I, Section 1.D.1.); and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council tabled the Administrative Plan, Proposed**  
6 **Gaming Distribution Formula change and Health Package during the September**  
7 **29, 2003 Special Session until the December 2003 General Session; and**

8 **WHEREAS, there are three districts requesting presentation of the Administrative Plan and**  
9 **two Districts who will be acting on the gaming revenue formula distribution**  
10 **during the month of December 2003; and**

11 **WHEREAS, it is necessary to set a special session for December 16, 2003, to address the**  
12 **Administrative Plan and the Proposed Gaming Revenue change.**

13 **NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby sets a**  
14 **Special Session for December 16, 2003 to address the Administrative Plan and**  
15 **Proposed Gaming Revenue Formula change.**

16 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 02<sup>ND</sup> Day of**  
17 **DECEMBER, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,997.8 FOR; 631.9**  
18 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
19 **Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
20 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
21 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
22 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
