

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving the Arizona Coordinated Plan to Mitigate and Prevent Environmental
and Other Impacts Caused by Undocumented Aliens Crossing Federal and
Tribal Lands)**

RESOLUTION NO. 03-552

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has participated with other Native American tribes and**
2 **federal agencies in the Borderland Management Task Force organized by the**
3 **Southwest Strategy United States-Mexico Government Relations Work Group to**
4 **create a coordinated response to impacts caused by the influx of border crossers; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Borderland Management Task Force has created an intergovernmental**
6 **agreement known as the "Arizona Coordinated Plan to Mitigate and Prevent**
7 **Environmental and Other Impacts Caused by Undocumented Aliens Crossing Federal**
8 **and Tribal Lands" (the "Arizona Coordinated Plan"); and**

9 **WHEREAS, the Arizona Coordinated Plan creates goals, objectives, and recommended actions**
10 **but does not commit tribes or federal agencies to specific financial funding to**
11 **accomplish these goals, objectives, and recommended actions; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the goals of the Arizona Coordinated Plan are as follows: Goal 1: Regain safety and**
13 **confidence of employees, visitors, and residents; Goal 2: Protect and restore**
14 **improvements and natural and cultural resources; Goal 3: Improve coordination and**
15 **cooperation among Federal, Tribal, State, county and local governments; Goal 4:**
16 **Increase government and public awareness of impacts caused by undocumented**
17 **aliens crossing Federal and Tribal land; Goal 5: Reduce and try to eliminate deaths**
18 **of undocumented aliens; and Goal 6: Seek the necessary funding to accomplish the**
19 **goals and objectives of this plan; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation supports these goals and agrees to apply its resources**
21 **and personnel to implementing these goals.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
23 **approves the Arizona Coordinated Plan in the form attached hereto and authorizes**
24 **and directs the Chairwoman of the Tohono O'odham Nation to sign it on behalf of the**
25 **Nation and to direct the Nation's departments and programs to take those actions**
26 **necessary to implement the goals and objectives of the Arizona Coordinated Plan.**

27 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03RD, Day**
28 **of DECEMBER, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0-**
29 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
30 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
31 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
32 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
33 **Stat. 984).**

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




