

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(FY 2004-Title VI Nutrition Services Incentive Program Budget October 1, 2003 through**  
**September 30, 2004)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 03-558**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated a program for the Elders of**  
2 **the Nation; and**

3 **WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Senior Services Program has been possible in part**  
4 **by Title VI of the Older American's Act of 1978 as amended and the Administration**  
5 **on Aging, Nutrition Services Incentive Program (NSIP); and**

6 **WHEREAS, services provided to the elders of the Nation are beneficial and services continue to**  
7 **be necessary to provide nutrition and socialization support; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Title VI Nutrition Services Incentive Program Grant Budget was prepared to**  
9 **utilize the Administration on Aging grant of \$3,527.00 to continue to provide**  
10 **nutrition and socialization services to eligible elders of the Nation.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 12           1. **It hereby approves the Title VI Nutrition Services Incentive Program Budget**  
13 **utilizing the Administration on Aging grant of \$3,527.00, to maintain services**  
14 **as per attachments.**
- 15           2. **The Tohono O'odham Nation officials to wit: The Chairwoman is hereby**  
16 **authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**  
17 **amendments affecting the funding levels of this contract shall be submitted**  
18 **for further approval by this Council.**

19 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 03<sup>rd</sup>, Day**  
20 **of DECEMBER, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0-**  
21 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
22 **Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
23 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
24 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
25 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
