5	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with
6		Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to fund and operate the Women, Infants and Children
7		(WIC) Program commenced on October 01, 2002 through September 30, 2006, which
8		was approved through Resolution No. 02-439; and
9	WHEREAS,	the services provided to eligible clients have been beneficial and services continue
10		to be necessary to help alleviate nutritional health risks and improve the health of
11		individuals at risk.
12	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:
13		1. The Tohono O'odham Nation approves the proposal for funding from the Inter-
14		Tribal Council of Arizona to continue to operate and provide services to eligible
15		women, infants and children.
16		2. The Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairwoman and Vice
17		Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and
18		execute the Memorandum of Agreement associated with this program, provided
19		however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding level of the
20		Memorandum of Agreement shall be submitted for further approval.
21		3. The Women, Infants, and Children program is authorized to expend funds from
22		this Memorandum of Agreement in the amount of \$134,700.00 beginning on
23		October 01, 2003 through September 30, 2004, subject to any increases by the
24		funding agency.
