

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approval of FY 2004 Women Infants & Children (WIC) Program Proposal)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 03-560**

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently providing preventive health care for**  
2 **Women, Infants and Children; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona receives funds from the United States Department**  
4 **of Agriculture for programs designed to benefit women, infants and children; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with**  
6 **Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to fund and operate the Women, Infants and Children**  
7 **(WIC) Program commenced on October 01, 2002 through September 30, 2006, which**  
8 **was approved through Resolution No. 02-439; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the services provided to eligible clients have been beneficial and services continue**  
10 **to be necessary to help alleviate nutritional health risks and improve the health of**  
11 **individuals at risk.**

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 13 **1. The Tohono O'odham Nation approves the proposal for funding from the Inter-**  
14 **Tribal Council of Arizona to continue to operate and provide services to eligible**  
15 **women, infants and children.**
- 16 **2. The Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairwoman and Vice**  
17 **Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and**  
18 **execute the Memorandum of Agreement associated with this program, provided**  
19 **however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding level of the**  
20 **Memorandum of Agreement shall be submitted for further approval.**
- 21 **3. The Women, Infants, and Children program is authorized to expend funds from**  
22 **this Memorandum of Agreement in the amount of \$134,700.00 beginning on**  
23 **October 01, 2003 through September 30, 2004, subject to any increases by the**  
24 **funding agency.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 05<sup>th</sup> Day**  
26 **of DECEMBER, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,029.1 FOR; 166.3**  
27 **AGAINST; 434.3 NOT VOTING; and [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
28 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**  
29 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**  
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
31 **Stat. 984).**
