

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Adopting the Tohono O'odham Nation Administrative Plan)**

RESOLUTION NO. 03-567

1 WHEREAS, the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, Article VII, Section 2(a) mandates the
2 Chairwoman of the Tohono O'odham Nation to develop an Administrative Plan to be
3 adopted by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and

4 WHEREAS, the Chairwoman of the Tohono O'odham Nation has submitted an Administrative
5 Plan to provide an overview of the state of the Nation, accomplishments of the Nation,
6 challenges and opportunities facing the Nation, outlining the governmental
7 structure of the Executive Branch, and proposed initiatives of the new
8 administration; and

9 WHEREAS, the Administrative Plan identifies the challenges facing the Tohono O'odham Nation,
10 setting goals to met the administrative initiatives of ensuring completion of the
11 funded projects, strengthening day-to-day governmental operations, building
12 infrastructure (roads, electric, sewer, water, and necessary codes), improving the
13 health and wellness of the Nation, addressing substandard housing, developing the
14 capacity for sustainable economic growth, addressing educational performance,
15 securing our future through investment in our youth and elders, preserving our past
16 and safeguarding our future, ensuring the safety of our tribal members, creation of
17 an International Affairs Office, and developing a Constitutional Review Committee;
18 and

19 WHEREAS, the Administrative Plan was presented to the districts of the Nation, the Legislative
20 Council, and the public for input.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby
22 adopt the Administrative Plan.

23 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 16TH Day
24 of DECEMBER, 2003 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,726.0 FOR; 903.7
25 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [01] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
26 Section 2 (a) of Article VII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the
27 Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
28 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
29 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
