

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Modification of the FY 2004 Budget passed by Resolution 2003-435 pertaining to the
Authorization to Expend carryover Bureau of Indian Affairs funds from BIA Account
10-5015 - Water Resources Study Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 04-009

1 **WHEREAS, on September 30, 2003, Resolution 2003-435 was passed by the Tohono O'odham**
2 **Legislative Council authorizing during the Fiscal Year 2004 of 638 Savings Carryover**
3 **and Expenditure of Bureau of Indian Affairs Funds for various of the Tohono O'odham**
4 **Nation's programs under a P.L. 93-638 Master Contract No. 1450CTH54T61071 (Master**
5 **Contract), which specifically set forth the amount of \$130,137.59 for the Water**
6 **Resources Study Program (WRSP); and**

7 **WHEREAS, in December 2003, the Grants and Contracts Department of the Tohono O'odham**
8 **Nation has calculated the accumulated savings for the WRSP in fiscal years 1997**
9 **through 2003 in its Bureau of Indian Affairs Funds under the Master Contract in the**
10 **amount of \$301,098.56; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the WRSP has proposed a budget amendment in fiscal year 2004 in the amount of**
12 **\$301,098.56 to increase its budget line items for Salaries, Fringe Benefits, Tuition &**
13 **Registration, Travel Expense, Mileage POV, Utilities, Communication Expense, Gas**
14 **Oil and Coolants, Supplies-Office, Supplies- Other, Program Supplies, Uniforms,**
15 **Lease and Rentals, Repair & Maintenance Equipment, Repair & Maintenance**
16 **Vehicles, Computer Maintenance, Professional Services, Non-Major Capital**
17 **Equipment, and Indirect Costs; and**

18 **WHEREAS, this budget amendment and savings proposal has been reviewed by the Water**
19 **Resources Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee and is recommended**
20 **for approval by the Legislative Council.**

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council authorizes the**
22 **carryover of savings of Bureau of Indian Affairs funds provided by the Nation's Master**
23 **Contract for the WRSP in the total amount of \$301,098.56.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the budget amendment of \$301,098.56 for the Water Resources**
25 **Study Program within the Bureau of Indian Affairs Master Contract Account 10-5015**
26 **in fiscal year 2004 is approved in accordance with the budget amendment attached**
27 **hereto.**


