4		of \$149,978.16; and
5	WHEREAS,	on September 30, 2003, Resolution 2003-454 was passed by the Tohono O'odham
6		Legislative Council authorizing during the Fiscal Year 2004 of Expenditure of
7		Environmental Protection Agency funds under the Grant in the amount of
8		\$149,978.16; and
9	WHEREAS,	in December 2003, the Grants and Contracts Department of the Tohono O'odham
10		$Nation\ has  recalculated\ the\ percentage\ rate\ pertaining\ to\ the\ calculation\ of\ Indirect$
11		Costs to be 16.69% instead of 16.7%; and
12	WHEREAS,	the WRSP has proposed a budget amendment in Fiscal Year 2004 in the amount of
13		\$149,978.16 so as to accommodate change in the rate applied to indirect costs, which
14		necessitates an increase its budget line item for Professional Services, while
15		decreasing its line item in the same amount for Indirect Costs; and
16	WHEREAS,	this budget amendment and savings proposal has been reviewed by the Water
17		Resources Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee and is recommended
18		for approval by the Legislative Council.
