12		\$23,262.09 so as to accommodate change in the rate applied to indirect costs, which
13		necessitates an increase its budget line item for Professional Services, while
14		decreasing its line item in the same amount for Indirect Costs; and

16		Resources Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee and is recommended
17		for approval by the Legislative Council.
