

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Modification of the FY 2004 Budget passed by Resolution 2003-449 pertaining to the
Authorization to Expend Environmental Protection Agency Grant Allocation funds
from EPA Border Study Account 11-5018 - Water Resources Study Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 04-012

1 **WHEREAS, the Water Resources Study Program of the Natural Resources Department was**
2 **awarded from the Environmental Protection Agency a continuing Border Study Grant**
3 **(Grant) for water quality planning and management in the amount of \$23,262.09; and**

4 **WHEREAS, on September 30, 2003, Resolution 2003-449 was passed by the Tohono O'odham**
5 **Legislative Council authorizing during the Fiscal Year 2004 of Expenditure of**
6 **Environmental Protection Agency funds under the Grant in the amount \$23,262.09;**
7 **and**

8 **WHEREAS, in December 2003, the Grants and Contracts Department of the Tohono O'odham**
9 **Nation has recalculated the percentage rate pertaining to the calculation of Indirect**
10 **Costs to be 16.69% instead of 16.7%; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the WRSP has proposed a budget amendment in Fiscal Year 2004 in the amount of**
12 **\$23,262.09 so as to accommodate change in the rate applied to indirect costs, which**
13 **necessitates an increase its budget line item for Professional Services, while**
14 **decreasing its line item in the same amount for Indirect Costs; and**

15 **WHEREAS, this budget amendment and savings proposal has been reviewed by the Water**
16 **Resources Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee and is recommended**
17 **for approval by the Legislative Council.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council acknowledges**
19 **that the 5% matching requirement of \$3754 for these funds will be met through its**
20 **in-kind services provided by the Water Resources Study Program from the Bureau of**
21 **Reclamation PL. 93-638 grant, agreement number 98-FG-00800.**

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the total budget funding during Fiscal Year 2004 of \$23,262.09 for**
23 **the Water Resources Study Program Account 11-5018 is approved in accordance**
24 **with the budget amendment attached hereto.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 06TH Day**
26 **of JANUARY, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
29 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
31 **Stat. 984).**

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


