# **RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL** (Proposal for four-month extension of the SAWRSA Allottee Project)

**RESOLUTION NO. 04-015** 

1	WHEREAS,	the proposed Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act (SAWRSA) Amendments
2		Act was introduced in Congress in February 2003, and Congressional hearings on the
3		Amendments were held September 30 and October 2, 2003; and
4	WHEREAS,	the SAWRSA Amendments require that the landowners of allotments on the San
5		Xavier Indian Reservation dismiss <u>U.S. v City of Tucson and Alvarez v. City of Tucson</u> ,
6		the class action lawsuits, which resulted in the 1982 SAWRSA and the proposed
7		Amendments; and
8	WHEREAS,	it is the goal of the San Xavier Allottees Association (SXAA) Board that the allottees
9		have an understanding of the SAWRSA Amendments in order to determine for
10		themselves if the Amendments are a fair settlement of the lawsuits, and to then
11		determine for themselves if they wish to be part of the plaintiff class that will dismiss
12		the lawsuits; and
13	WHEREAS,	the SXAA Board requested and received funding from the Tohono O'odham
14		Legislative Council (Resolution #03-114) in March 2003 for the SAWRSA Allottee
15		Project for the purpose of educating and informing the allottees about the SAWRSA
16		Amendments and to archive the documents related to the Amendments for future
17		reference; and
18	WHEREAS,	it has been determined by the SXAA Board that the SAWRSA Allottee Project needs to
19		be extended another four months to enable the Project staff to continue outreach on
20		an individual to individual basis in an effort to reach more landowners at San Xavier
21		and on the main Tohono O'odham Reservation, and to fund a video production of the
22		Amendments, which will be distributed to landowners on and off the Tohono
23		O'odham reservations; and
24	WHEREAS,	the SXAA Board has presented and discussed the four-month extension of the SAWRSA
25		Allottee Project proposal and budget to the Budget and Finance and the Water
26		Resources Committees of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council.
27	NOW, THER	EFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves
28		additional funding to the San Xavier Allottees Association, Inc. Board from the
29		SAWRSA Trust fund in the amount of \$47,631.00 to fund an additional four months of
30		the SAWRSA Allottee Project as described in the attached proposal and report.
