4	WHEREAS,	the Florence Community's 20 acres of land was added to the lands of the Papago
5		Tribe as part of the Gu Achi District on September 10 th , 1978 and additional 22 acres
6		was added to the Papago Tribe on October 29th 1985; and
7	WHEREAS,	the Gu Achi District Representatives and members of Florence Community
8		reported, an individual has approached the community members and Community
9		Representatives offering to sell 64 acres of land adjacent to the east side existing
10		Florence Community; and
11	WHEREAS,	the members living in the Florence Community have raised issues of over
12		crowdedness and lack of additional land for future generations to establish
13		homesteads; and
14	WHEREAS,	the additional land will create Economic Development opportunities near the
15		town of Florence; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Community Representatives made their request to the Gu Achi District Council
17		and the Natural Resources Committee and the Legislative Council.
18	NOW THER	EFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT, The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council,

20		community and provide the nation and district with economic development
21		opportunities.
22		${\bf 2.} {\bf The Nation's Chairwoman and Tohono O'odham Legislative Council initiate the Council initiate $
23		process of negotiations to purchase the land adjacent east of the Florence
24		Community(Gu Achi District).
25		3. The Gu Achi District Officials and Florence Community Representatives be
26		involved in every step of the process to acquire the land.
27		4. If the land adjacent to Florence lands cannot be purchased that the Nation
28		fervently investigates and negotiates for the purchase of lands near the
29		Florence Community(Gu Achi District) for the members of Florence
30		Community.
31	BE IT FINAL	LY RESOLVED that the pre-purchase cost be funded under the Land Acquisition
32		Fund.
