

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Rescinding Legislative Order No. 03-344)**

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 04-031**


1 **WHEREAS, on August 04, 2003 the Legislative Council did interview applicant Vivian Hedrington**  
2 **for the Legislative Council Secretary position; and**  
3 **WHEREAS, Vivian Hedrington was duly then certified and officially appointed to serve as the**  
4 **Tohono O'odham Legislative Council Secretary; and**  
5 **WHEREAS, Vivian Hedrington's official term of Legislative Council Secretary was appointed**  
6 **until June 2005; and**  
7 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council has re-visited this appointment on February 09, 2004 to**  
8 **discuss the Council's concerns of said appointment; and**  
9 **WHEREAS, it has been over six (6) months that the Legislative Secretary, Vivian Hedrington, was**  
10 **servng in her official capacity as Legislative Secretary; and**  
11 **WHEREAS, it is this Council's decision to rescind Legislative Order No. 03-344 which certifies the**  
12 **appointment of Vivian Hedrington as Legislative Council Secretary until June 2005.**  
13 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby rescinds**  
14 **Legislative Order No. 03-344.**

16 **The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 09<sup>th</sup> Day of**  
17 **FEBRUARY, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,993.8 FOR; 170.3**  
18 **AGAINST; 465.6 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**  
19 **Section 1 (b) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**  
20 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**  
21 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**  
22 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
