

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting the San Xavier District's People Wellness House and Education Department
Grant Application to the Arizona Juvenile Justice Program's Title II Formula Grant (AZJJP))

RESOLUTION NO. 04-039

1 **WHEREAS, the mission of the San Xavier Education Department is to assist San Xavier**
2 **Community members to value education, achieve educational success, participate**
3 **in social and physical fitness activities, and gain understanding, appreciation, and**
4 **knowledge of Tohono O'odham language and culture; and**

5 **WHEREAS, the mission of the San Xavier People Wellness Department is to promote community-**
6 **based wellness through education, individual and/or group services addressing**
7 **chemical/behavioral addiction prevention and intervention for the San Xavier**
8 **Community, and to encourage a working partnership between Native and Western**
9 **medicines to better identify individuals and relationship problems and address**
10 **family dysfunctions; and**

11 **WHEREAS, these two departments wish to engage in a collaborative project to increase the**
12 **effectiveness of their services to the youth of San Xavier; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the AZJJP now has a grant opportunity available to fund collaborative youth**
14 **prevention projects; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the departments have developed a proposal that includes the creation of a peer youth**
16 **group for San Xavier youth, that will meet three times per week to engage in tutoring**
17 **and substance abuse prevention activities; and**

18 **WHEREAS, this program will include stipends for youth with good attendance, and contracting**
19 **with an outside prevention specialist to assist with the development and**
20 **coordination of the program, and these costs will be funded by the grant; and**

21 **WHEREAS, there is no in-kind requirement for this grant; and**

22 **WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council has passed a resolution supporting this grant**
23 **application.**

24 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepts,**
25 **understands, and supports the Education and People Wellness Departments' joint**
26 **application to the 2004 AZ JJP.**

27 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby authorizes San**
28 **Xavier District officials to execute all necessary documents related to obtaining**
29 **OJJDP grant funds, and with programmatic and financial reporting requirements.**


