

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving a Memorandum of Agreement Between the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation"),
the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI") and the Southern Arizona Children's Advocacy
Center ("SACAC"))

RESOLUTION NO. 04-054

1 **WHEREAS, the FBI and the Tohono O'odham Police Department ("TOPD") have proposed the**
2 **establishment of a Children's Forensic Interviewing Facility ("CFIF") in Sells, Arizona,**
3 **which proposal has been supported by the United States Attorney for the District of**
4 **Arizona, the Southern Arizona Children's Advocacy Center, the Tohono O'odham**
5 **Prosecutor's Office, and the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services; and**

6 **WHEREAS, interviews of the Nation's children who are alleged victims of child sexual or physical**
7 **abuse currently are conducted in Tucson at the offices of the Southern Arizona**
8 **Children's Advocacy Center; and**

9 **WHEREAS, placing the CFIF in Sells benefits the Nation's children and families by shortening the**
10 **distance that children need to travel to participate in such interviews, and is**
11 **therefore in the best interests of the Nation; and**

12 **WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Agreement has been negotiated between the Nation, the FBI and**
13 **the SACAC under which the Nation will provide a building for the CFIF (Building 24 in**
14 **the BIA Circle in Sells), the FBI will equip and maintain the facility, and the SACAC will**
15 **provide the forensic interviewer to interview the children; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee of the Legislative Council has reviewed the**
17 **Memorandum of Agreement and recommends approval by the Legislative Council.**

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves the**
19 **Memorandum of Agreement Between the Tohono O'odham Nation, the Federal**
20 **Bureau of Investigation and the Southern Arizona Children's Advocacy Center**
21 **substantially in the form attached hereto, and authorizes the Chairwoman or Vice-**
22 **Chairman of the Nation to execute it on behalf of the Nation, provided that any**
23 **amendments to the agreement in the future shall be presented to the Domestic**
24 **Affairs Committee and the Legislative Council for review and approval.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 13TH Day**
26 **of FEBRUARY, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,463.4 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 166.3 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
29 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
30 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
31 **Stat. 984).**


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


