

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Amending Resolution No. 03-440, "Approval of the Application and Acceptance of the  
Grant Award for Indian Environmental General Assistance Program (GAP) Grant")**

RESOLUTION NO. 04-071

1 WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 03-440, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council accepted \$275,000  
2 in new funding for the continuation of the Indian Environmental General Assistance  
3 Program (GAP); and

4 WHEREAS, the GAP Grant project period extends from August 1, 2002 through July 31, 2006; and

5 WHEREAS, as part of a continuation grant, the FY 2003 Remaining Budget (\$54,476.38 needs to  
6 be added to the FY 2004 Budget (\$275,000); and

7 WHEREAS, the program is adding three new line items: 750 Major Capitol and 892 Non-Major  
8 Capital Equipment and 893 Non-Major Office Equipment.

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby amends  
10 Resolution No. 03-440 in the following manner:

- 11 1. Adding the FY 2003 Remaining Budget (\$54,476.38) into the FY 2004 Budget  
12 (\$275,000).
- 13 2. Line Items 750 Major Capitol and 892 Non-Major Capital Equipment and 893 Non-  
14 Major Office Equipment to be included into the FY 2004 GAP budget.
- 15 3. Authorizing TONEPA to expend all available funds awarded pursuant to  
16 Cooperative Agreement #GA-97924901-2 beginning August 1, 2002.

17 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham  
18 Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official  
19 are authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any  
20 amendments affecting the funds or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for  
21 further prior approval.

22 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 01<sup>ST</sup> Day  
23 of MARCH, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0-  
24 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by  
25 Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono  
26 O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
27 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
28 Stat. 984).
