

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of amendment to the FY2004 Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona Women,
Infants & Children (WIC) Program Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-076

1 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently providing preventive health care for**
2 **Women, Infants and Children; and**

3 **WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona receives funds from the United States**
4 **Department of Agriculture for programs designed to benefit women, infants and**
5 **children; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with**
7 **Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to fund and operate the Women, Infants and Children**
8 **(WIC) Program which commenced on October 01, 2001 through September 30, 2006;**
9 **which was approved through Resolution No. 02-439; and**

10 **WHEREAS, due to an increase in the ITCA/WIC agreement of \$1,444.02, based on the formula**
11 **utilized for funding amount, a budget modification is submitted for review and**
12 **approval by the Department of Human Services, Division of Community Health.**

13 **NOW ,THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:**

- 14 1. **The Tohono O'odham Nation approves the increase in the funding amount for**
15 **the Women, Infants and Children Program.**
- 16 2. **The Tohono O'odham Nation Official, to wit: the Chairwoman and Vice**
17 **Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and**
18 **execute the Memorandum of Agreement associated with this program, provided**
19 **however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding level of the**
20 **Memorandum of Agreement shall be submitted for further approval.**
- 21 3. **The Women, Infants, and Children program is authorized to expend funds from**
22 **this Memorandum of Agreement in the amount of \$134,688.58 beginning on**
23 **October 01, 2003 through September 30, 2004, subject to any increases by the**
24 **funding agency.**

25 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 02ND Day**
26 **of MARCH, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0-**
27 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
28 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the**
29 **Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant**
30 **Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June**
31 **18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




