

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Amendment No. 1 to Attorney Contract with Clapham & Curry, P.L.C.)**

RESOLUTION NO. 04-083

1 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 03-424, the Legislative Council authorized funding of the**
2 **Office of Attorney General and other Executive Branch programs for the six-month**
3 **period from October 1, 2003 to March 31, 2004; and**

4 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution No. 03-507, the Tohono O'odham Nation**
5 **(the "Nation") entered into an Attorney Contract with Clapham & Curry, P.L.C. (the**
6 **"Attorneys") for the purpose of providing legal representation to the Nation in**
7 **connection with gaming and other matters; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract is in the amount of \$60,000 for the period from November 10,**
9 **2003 to March 31, 2004; and**

10 **WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 04-042, the Legislative Council authorized funding of the**
11 **Office of Attorney General and other Executive Branch programs for the twelve-**
12 **month period ending September 30, 2004; and**

13 **WHEREAS, additional funding is required to continue representation of the Nation by the**
14 **Attorneys under the Attorney Contract; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Attorney General has proposed Amendment No. 1 to the Attorney Contract which**
16 **increases the Contract amount from \$60,000 to \$120,000 and extends the Contract**
17 **term through September 30, 2004; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the budget of the Office of Attorney General (01-1031-810) has sufficient funds for the**
19 **increased Contract amount; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs and Budget & Finance Committees recommend approval by the**
21 **Legislative Council of Amendment No. 1 to the Attorney Contract.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 23 **1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council approves Amendment No. 1 to the**
24 **Attorney Contract, in the form attached hereto, which increases the Contract**
25 **amount to \$120,000 and extends the Contract term through September 30, 2004.**
26 **2. Funding for Amendment No. 1 shall be provided from the budget of the Office of**
27 **Attorney General (01-1031-810).**
28 **3. The Chairwoman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute Amendment**
29 **No. 1.**

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 2ND Day of MARCH, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,534.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 95.7 NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




