

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval to accept and expend USEPA Grant Award of \$50,000 for the Undocumented Migrant (UDM) Waste Demonstration Project)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-086

1 **WHEREAS, Article XVIII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation sets out the Council's**
2 **continuing responsibility to assure for all members safe and healthful surroundings;**
3 **and**

4 **WHEREAS, the lands of the Tohono O'odham Nation have been severely impacted by the large**
5 **amount of waste left by Undocumented Migrants as they pass through the Nation's**
6 **lands; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Solid Waste Management Program (SWMP) is tasked with the removal of solid**
8 **waste from the Nation's lands; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the USEPA has allocated \$50,000 to enable the SWMP to conduct a demonstration**
10 **project that will perform a waste composition study and a market analysis to**
11 **determine the amount and types of discarded waste and whether the recyclability**
12 **value of the waste can sustain a business and/or program to continue to address this**
13 **problem in the future.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves**
15 **the acceptance of \$50,000 from the USEPA for the Undocumented Migrant (UDM)**
16 **Waste Demonstration Project.**

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council that the Tohono**
18 **O'odham Nation's Official, to wit: the Chairwoman, Vice Chairman and any**
19 **designated person are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant,**
20 **provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding levels of the grant**
21 **shall be submitted for further prior approval**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Solid Waste Management Program is authorized to expend**
23 **funds from this grant as detailed in the attached budget.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 02ND, Day**
25 **of MARCH, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,871.0 FOR; 758.7**
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
28 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
30 **Stat. 984).**




