

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Amendment to the Facility Maintenance FY 2004 Operating Budget to
provide for the funding of Facility Maintenance Supervisor's position and the
transfer of additional funds into the Facility Maintenance Reserve)

RESOLUTION NO. 04-087

1 **WHEREAS, during recent fiscal years, the Nation elected to freeze and not fund certain vacant**
2 **positions due to the economic conditions affecting the Nation's financial position;**
3 **and**

4 **WHEREAS, one of the positions affected was the Facility Maintenance Program's Building and**
5 **Grounds Supervisor; and**

6 **WHEREAS, an assessment of the General Support Services' Facility Maintenance Program by the**
7 **program manager has determined that in order for the program to properly deliver**
8 **services, the position of the Building and Grounds Supervisor needs to be reclassified**
9 **and funded; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the Facility Maintenance Program Manager recommends that two currently vacant**
11 **positions be frozen to make funds available for the Facility Maintenance Supervisor,**
12 **further that any additional funds available be transferred to the Facility Maintenance**
13 **Reserve to assist in conducting minor repairs of the Nation's facilities; and**

14 **WHEREAS, a budget amendment has been prepared and presented to the Legislative Oversight**
15 **committee addressing the recommendations made, which the Committee has**
16 **reviewed and approves of.**

17 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the**
18 **attached FY 2004 budget amendment of the Facility Maintenance Program is hereby**
19 **approved as presented.**

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council does hereby authorize the transfer of**
21 **\$8,000 from the Facility Maintenance Program to the Facility Maintenance Reserve.**

22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the transfer of operational funds to the reserve shall not affect the**
23 **base for either budget and it is only for the current fiscal year.**

24 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on the 02ND, Day**
25 **of MARCH, 2004 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 2,629.7 FOR; -0-**
26 **AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by**
27 **Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono**
28 **O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -**
29 **Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**
30 **Stat. 984).**




